URGENT APPEAL FOR ACTION REGARDING ONGOING WATER CRISIS IN DELAREYVILLE

AfriForum is writing to express our deep concern regarding the ongoing water crisis affecting the community of Delareyville. As of today, the area has been without water for 15 consecutive days, and despite our previous efforts to communicate with your office, we have yet to receive any form of feedback or progress report.

The continued lack of water is causing severe distress and hardship to residents, with many households unable to meet even their most basic daily needs. We have also been informed that growing frustration within the community has led to plans for a public protest in response to the ongoing poor service delivery and water supply failure. AfriForum hereby urges the municipality to:

1. Prioritise the urgent repair and restoration of the Delareyville pump station, and
2. Provide the community with a clear and realistic timeframe for when the water supply will be fully restored.

Failure to address this matter promptly not only risks a serious humanitarian situation but also threatens public order and confidence in local government services.

We trust that the municipality will treat this communication with the seriousness it deserves and respond without further delay. We remain committed to constructive engagement and look forward to your urgent response.
