  8. **Impact on surrounding community**  
What measures will the City implement to mitigate the impact on surrounding residents and businesses, including matters related to security, public order, sanitation, and general safety in the area?
  9. **Definition of “temporary”**  
The relocation has reportedly been described as temporary. Please indicate what timeframe the City considers to be “temporary” in this context.
  10. **Stakeholder engagement**  
Has the City engaged with other relevant stakeholders in this process, including community structures, businesses, SAPS, churches, NGO’s or civil society organisations, or is the matter being handled internally without broader collaboration?
  11. **Public participation**  
Was any form of public participation or consultation conducted prior to the decision to establish the tent settlement at this location?

We further request that the City provide responses to the above questions by no later than 13 March 08:00, given that it has been indicated that the relocation may already commence as early as 17 March.

AfriForum believes that matters of this nature require transparency, proper planning, and meaningful engagement with affected communities. We remain willing to engage constructively with the City to ensure that solutions are implemented responsibly and sustainably.
