REQUEST FOR FEEDBACK: NO PROGRESS ON LAND TITLE ADJUSTMENT – DENNILTON LANDOWNERS ASSOCIATION

My letters of 4 April, 28 April and 12 May 2026 and your letters of 10 April and 19 May 2026 serve as reference. I attach the correspondence for ease of reference.

On 4 April 2026 I respectfully requested to be informed of the steps taken, and planned by the Department of Land Reform and Rural Development (DLRRD), to bring the Dennilton land title adjustment matter to finalisation. You requested a written and signed mandate on 10 April, which was provided to you on 12 May 2026. On 19 May you undertook to provide a comprehensive report in relation to the land title adjustment applications of the Dennilton Landowners Association.

More than three months have now gone by and you have not honoured this commitment. This lack of action on the very important matter of land ownership speaks volumes about the government's complete lack of commitment to property rights and securing title deeds for citizens. It also confirms AfriForum's serious concerns regarding government's continued efforts to enable government officials and various levels to expropriate property without compensation.

Members of the Dennilton Landowners Association are facing serious challenges as a result of the lack of title deeds for their properties. As I write this letter, the construction of a pipeline and a solar power plant is under way whilst the land rights of these citizens are trampled upon. They are also facing challenges with illegal invasions of their commonage and are concerned about the transfer of property to illegitimate persons.

The first twenty-eight land title adjustment applications were submitted to the Limpopo Department of Land Reform and Rural Development as far back as July 2017. The complete lack of real progress, despite meetings with and promises made by officials, can only be described as a grave injustice. Justice delayed is justice denied.

I mentioned before that this unreasonable delay with the processing of land title adjustment applications is destroying trust in the process and government in general, which threatens belief in the rule of law and social stability in the long run.

You are hereby requested to provide the answers (with documentary proof) to the following questions, based on the commitments made to property owners during the meeting of 15 May 2024. (The back-to-office report of this meeting is attached for ease of reference.)

1. Were valuers and surveyors appointed and did they commence work?
2. Were commissioners allocated to this land title adjustment process?
3. Was a submission made to the Minister for approval of the allocation of commissioners?
4. Were commissioners trained to perform their duties?
5. Were commissioners informed of their claim rates?
6. Did the allocated commissioners gazette the title adjustment intention?

You are further requested to provide the following information:

1. What other steps has the DLRRD taken to bring the Dennilton land titles adjustment matter to finalisation?
2. What steps does the DLRRD plan to take to bring the matter to finalisation?

ENQUIRY: LAND TITLES ADJUSTMENT – DENNILTON LANDOWNERS ASSOCIATION

I trust that this letter finds you well.

AfriForum was approached by the Dennilton Landowners Association with a request for support to ensure the finalisation of applications for land titles adjustment in terms of the Land Titles Adjustment Act Number 111 of 1993.

It is our understanding that your office already has full details of the matter. We will gladly furnish further information or facilitate a meeting with the Dennilton Landowners Association if it is required to ensure the finalisation of the existing applications, as well as the further applications that will flow from successful historic applications.

AfriForum was informed that the first twenty-eight applications were submitted to the Limpopo Department of Land Reform and Rural Development as far back as July 2017. There have since been various interactions with the provincial department and with your office. It is unfortunate that to date, no real progress has been made with the applications, despite meetings with and promises made by officials on provincial and national level.

The Dennilton Landowners are also facing challenges with illegal invasions of their commonage and are concerned about the transfer of property to illegitimate persons with the involvement of the provincial department which warrants urgent investigation. There are also allegations that the local authority is doing development without proper consultation with or paying compensation to landowners.

Mathabatha.

Purpose of the meeting/ event	To present progress report on Moutse 2 project and to outline the processes flow the Department will follow to assist them with regularization and adjustment of title deeds.
Brief background	➤ Motse 2 is comprised of three projects , namely Portion 46 of the farm Goederede 60 JS, Portion 25 of the farm Kikvorschfontein 57 JS and Portion 21 of Dennilton Agricultural Holdings 38 JS. ➤ It is estimated that there are about 160 beneficiaries in Goederede, 200 in Kikvorschfontein and more or less 400 in Dennilton Agricultural Holdings. ➤ The properties are situated in the Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality under Sekhukhune district in Limpopo Province. ➤ Beneficiaries have applied for the Department of Agriculture, Land Reform and rural Development to assist them with title adjustment in 2017 around the month of July. ➤ Land title adjustment Act 111 of 1993 has that provision of allocating title to claimants who are claiming the land without registered title.

	lands and they are also using them for grazing and cultivating variety of crops. ➤ The Distribution and transfer of certain State Land Act 119 of 1993 also provide for distribution and transfer of certain land belonging to the State and designated by the Minister as land to be dealt with in accordance with it.
Key activities / discussion points / decisions reached	CURRENT PROJECT STATUS: ➤ The project is registered on BAS. The purpose of registration is for the purposes of service providers (Valuers, Surveyors) to be able to be paid after rendering their services. ➤ Pool of Commissioners is already created on the system. THE NEXT PHASE: ➤ Commissioners in the pool will be allocated to each nine land title adjustment projects. ➤ The Department is planning to have prepared a submission to the Minister for her to approve the Commissioners allocation to projects. ➤ Commissioners will be trained on how to perform their duties and they will be given standard claiming rates. ➤ Commissioners will be introduced to beneficiaries just after being approved by the Minister. ➤ Update on project progress will be given to beneficiaries timeously. ➤ Commissioners will gazette the title adjustment intention of the three projects in the Government gazette, so that those parties that are affected or have interest in the properties concerned can come forward with their concerns or disputes. Some challenges were highlighted during the meeting, some were referred to the Department and some to the beneficiaries themselves: ➤ To the Department beneficiaries were not pleased about the pace the project is running, they feel like officials made empty promises which makes them not to trust the Department and that makes other beneficiaries to be afraid to submit their title deeds and other important documents. The Director: TRI acknowledged the complaint and offer words of apologies on behalf of the Office. Challenges that affect beneficiaries: ➤ Internal conflicts where siblings are fighting amongst themselves to own that small piece of land. ➤ Beneficiaries also indicated that some of them no longer have copies of title deeds, they were advised to visit nearest Deeds office to request those copies.

	Each application was also processed, the property was purchased and registered under the name of a local Chief. ➤ It was also indicated that there are some portions at Dennilton Agricultural Holdings which are situated across the river which are not included in the application. ➤ Beneficiaries also enquire about the development fundings that can be available for them. As they are title holders they can go to financial institutions and apply for funds.
Way forward	• The Office (DALRRD) will submit report of the meeting before 1st of June 2024, the report will include emphasis of submission of outstanding document by all beneficiaries. • Documents that must be submitted will be listed on the communique that will be sent to beneficiaries from the Department. • Due date for submission to the Minister is the end of June 2024. • Applications will be dealt with according to first come first served rule. All applications will be processed as soon as they are received.
Closure	The meeting was closed by prayer by Mr. Tloung. The meeting was adjourned at 13h20.
